POOL RULES

The Oak Grove Home Owners Association (OGHA) reserves the right to refuse admittance to, or eject from, the premises, any person failing to comply with any of the following health and safety regulations.

1. **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY – SWIM AT OWN RISK.** The OGHA is not responsible for accidents in and around the pool.
2. Pool hours are from 06:30 AM to 11:00 PM.
3. Friday, Saturday, and Sunday from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM and 9:00 PM to 11:00 PM is reserved for ADULT SWIM TIME.
4. A responsible adult, parent, or guardian, who is a resident and at least 19 years of age, must at all times accompany children under the age of 16.
5. Small parties are allowed Monday through Friday. You must advise the Pool chairman or a member of the Board of Directors at least one week in advance. The pool will still be open for Members.
6. The host must accompany guests. Four (4) guests per household beyond immediate family of the resident.
7. **NO GLASS** containers allowed.
8. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ALCOHOL, FIREARMS OR DRUGS BE PERMITTED IN THE SURROUNDING AREAS. ANYONE SEEN ENGAGING IN THE USE OF THESE ITEMS WILL BE SUBJECT TO LOSS OF PRIVILEGES FOR A PERIOD TO BE DETERMINED BY THE OGHA BOARD.**
9. No food in pool. Picnic tables are provided as eating places.
10. The OGHA is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Any articles left at pool will be disposed of.
11. Only proper swim wear in pool. No cut offs or infants in diapers.
12. Any person having an infection, communicable disease, or having open blisters is prohibited from using the pool.
13. Running, rough play, excessive noise, including loud radios, is forbidden in the pool area. Advise children not to play on pool rope, as weight will break it.
14. Vandals will be prosecuted.
15. There is to be no littering.
16. Spitting, blowing nose, or discharging of bodily waste in pool is strictly prohibited. The pool is inspected periodically by the County Health Department and is subject to closing by this agency.
17. No animals in the pool area.
18. Keep gate closed at all times. Climbing over the fence is prohibited and is regarded as trespassing.
19. The cost for the pool key is \$15.00 (ten dollars.) Only one key per unit will be issued. Keys are not to be duplicated. When you move, if you return the pool key, we will be happy to refund the initial cost of \$15.00.
20. The cost for replacing a lost key is \$15.00 (fifteen dollars.)
21. Keys will be issued only to units that are current on dues and assessments.

A COPY OF THIS DOCUMENT, SIGNED BY RESIDENT, MUST BE ON FILE WITH THE POOL CHAIRMAN.

I HAVE READ THESE RULES AND AGREE TO INSTRUCT ALL WHO RESIDE AT MY RESIDENCE BELOW TO ABIDE BY THEM.
